CASHMERE DOESKIN BLAZERS

100% Khan Cashmere

Holland & Sherry's finest blazer quality is woven from luxurious Khan Cashmere. This distinctive collection features a smooth sensuous *doeskin* cloth finish with a beautiful handle and excellent selection of colours.

Cashmere comes from the fleece of goats living in the high uplands of countries such as Mongolia. The luxurious fibres are gently gathered from the goats by carefully hand-combing their fleece. The soft undercoat or underlayer of hair protects the goats during the harsh winter months and sheds naturally in the Spring. After combing, the tough outer guard hairs are separated out leaving only the finest fibres. Cashmere is one of the most valued and exquisite of animal hairs because of its incredible softness.

Transforming woven cashmere into a luxurious finished product has remained unchanged for hundreds of years. After washing and pressing there is a special raising process carried out on cashmere. This involves the use of natural teasel heads. Historically, teasels were made into brushes and the cloth gently brushed. Today the dried heads of the teasel plant are placed between bars, which are fixed round a large revolving drum. When the teasel heads are wet, they become flexible and the hooked ends gently tease out and align the cashmere fibres to produce the characteristic luxurious ripple finish.

CLASSIC OVERCOATS & TOPCOATS

Cashmere and Merino Wool

Overcoats have been worn for formal use throughout the world for centuries. Indicative of social status or worn as part of a professional or military uniform the overcoat has evolved; only a few have survived as classics.

Overcoats are...

- Generally long and worn below the knee or shin.
- As the term suggests is an item of clothing worn over a suit or dress.
- Made from heavy woollen fabrics like Doeskins or fur as they are worn to protect the wearer from the outdoor elements.
- Woollen cloths are made from woollen spun yarns; the yarn

is much thicker and loftier than that of a worsted spun cloth making them warmer to wear.

Topcoats are...

- Shorter than overcoats and are generally worn above the knee.
- Are lighter in weight than overcoats and are generally worn mid season.
- Are traditionally made from a covert constructed fabric.
- A covert fabric is a warp faced fabric that is mottled in appearance. This is achieved by weaving a grandrelle warp with a solid coloured weft; a grandrelle being a contrasting 2-ply yarn.

The cashmere has then been carefully blended with 18µ merino wool to produce a range of opulent melange colours that are beyond compare.

The combing and blending of the fibres continues, gently removing any short staple fibres from the blend.

Once all the longer fibres are in perfect alignment and the desired level of colour achieved, the fibres are gently twisted together in a soft 'S' direction.

The soft 'S' twist in the finished yarn and the gentle scour that the cloth undergoes contribute to the unparalleled softness, lightness and warmth of the cloth.
